# Day 1. - Mexico City

## Day 2. - Mexico City


We'll begin our sacred tour visiting the main churches of the **Historic Centre**, sample of the Mexican colonial period.

# Day 4.- Queretaro / San Miguel de Allende / Guanajuato

Departure to the city of San Miguel Allende, visiting the Gothic Parish of San Miguel Arcangel, sample of European Cathedral. On the way to Guanajuato, will visit the Sanctuary of Atotonilco, known as the "Mexican Sistine Chapel".

## Day 5. - Guanajuato

Walking tour in the singular city of **Guanajuato**, which became the most important silversmith center in New Spain, visiting the principal churches, testimony of this richness.

### Day 6. - Guanajuato / Leon

Departure to the city of **León**. Visit to the Cathedral of **Nuestra Señora de la Luz** and

the Templo Expiatorio, sample of Gothic Architecture, well known for its catacombs.



Departure to Mexico City. On the way will make a stop in the city of Celaya where will visit the Cathedral and El Carmen Sanctuary. Arrival to Mexico City.
